

Students from high-income families receive significantly higher non-academic admissions ratings than students from lower-income families with comparable SAT/ACT scores.

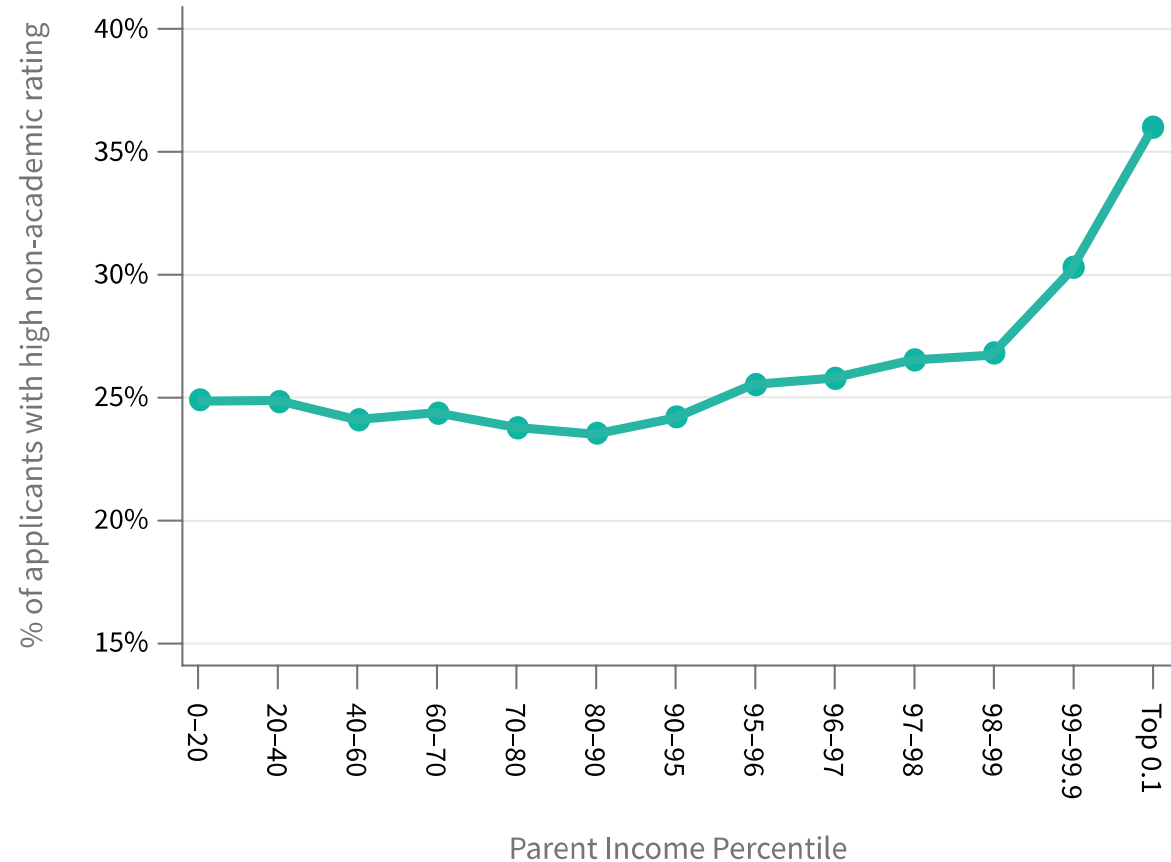
